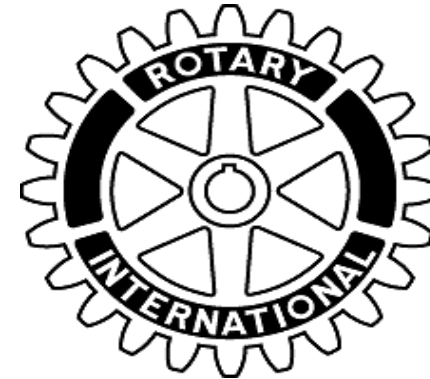

Last Week's Program:



Cece Axton & Nannoe Westbrook spoke on Polio Survivors and Post-Polio afflictions. Both ladies are polio survivors and are members of Polio Epic, Inc., an organization that reaches out to help polio survivors. This organization is world-wide, but has many members in Arizona. It's website is www.polioepic.com. They noted that there are 4 types of Polio: Paralytic, Non-paralytic, Paralytic & Lung, and Wild-one for which there is no vaccine. Post-polio is secondary disability that affects polio survivors, showing up in later years and generally triggered by some type of trauma. Polio Epic is there to help and sends out information showing with Post-polio is, how it is diagnosed, what are some of the symptoms and what can be done. Post-polio affects survivors in different ways and there is no cure. As Axton says, "It's great to have a group to share your story with, with those who understand."
