Chet Davis - After 33 years in the Aerospace Industry, Chet moved to Green Valley in 1990 and immediately became a community

volunteer. As a member of GVCCC's Traffic and Arroyos Committee, Chet spoke on road conditions in Green Valley and some of the upcoming projects to improve these conditions. His topic, "Where has Continental Gone",



gave us insight to construction on Continental Road at Camino Del Sol and at the I-19 Freeway.

At the present time, a round-a-bout is being installed at Continental and Del Sol and roadways in both directions from Del Sol are being revised. From the Rapid Sound exit on Continental to Del Sol, there will end up being one traffic lane along with a multi-use lane in both directions. The round-a-bout should alleviate t-bone accidents at the intersection, where there has been many through the years.

At I-19, the northbound off-ramp to Continental is now closed and will be for about 8 months. The off-ramp and frontage road will be re-routed and come out at a traffic signal on Continental. The frontage road will then be extended to the Canoa Interchange. This total project should take around 18 months. There will be a construction meeting every Thursday to review progress and the community will be kept up-dated.

Abrego, which is in much needed repair, is not on the radar scope of Pima County at this time, but GVCCC is pushing this project.

LaCanada is scheduled to be re-paved from Duval Mine Road to Esperanza sometime in early 2010.

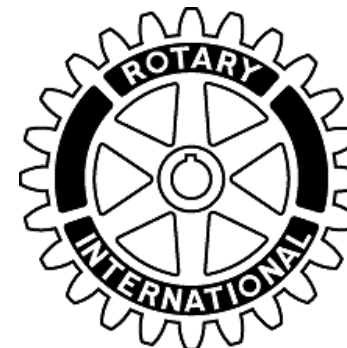

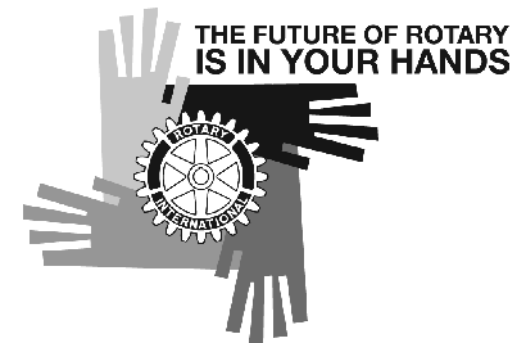
The Desert Wheel
