**John Kennedy & Mark Rafferty**, of Kennedy  
Partners, a Capital Improvement Planning  
and Implementation  
company, spoke about  
the solar installation  
project being projected  
for Continental School.  
Kennedy Partners will  
be the Administrator  
and Integrator of the project. Shaded parking  
will be provided in the school's parking lots  
and Solar Photovoltaic Electric Generating  
Systems (solar panels) will be installed on  
them. This is approximately a \$3M project



with Fed stimulus picking up 30%, utilities  
50% and the school district around 20%. This  
20% will be paid by the yearly electric bills.  
The panels will provide approximately 125%  
of the current electrical usage and what isn't  
used by the school will be returned to the  
utility company. It is estimated that the pay-  
off of the capital will take about 10-15 years  
and then the school will be without an  
electrical bill, which now amounts to around  
\$110,000 a year. This will be a zero cost for  
the school district, which is good for the  
school district and good for the community.  
Kennedy Partners will provide for the  
maintenance and administration of the system  
until it is taken over by the Continental School  
District. Kennedy Partners will also set-up a  
Science Education Foundation to support the  
development and maintenance of Public  
School curriculum focusing on Energy  
Conservation and Renewable Energy  
Systems and to support Educational  
Equipment, Materials, Facilities and Faculty  
necessary to implement the curriculum.

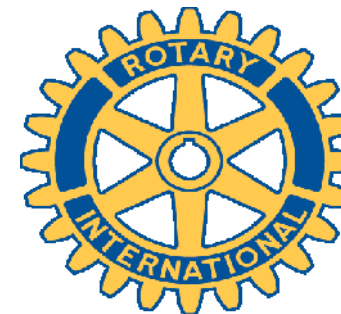

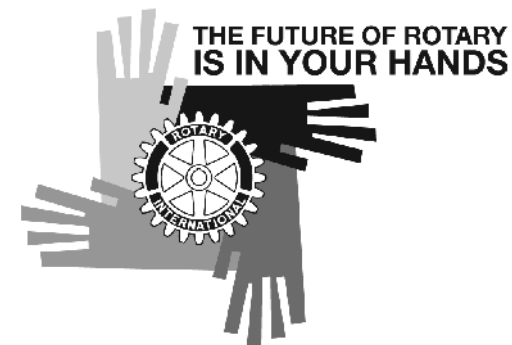
