Rotary Minute by Andy Heideman:

Membership increases during 2008-09 Rotary year!

In a year of economic havoc that rocked global markets and shook consumer confidence, Rotary International's most important asset – its members – steadily grew.

As of 30 June, the end of the 2008-09 RI year, there were 1,234,527 members in 33,790 Rotary clubs. That's an increase of 3,044 members and 520 clubs from the previous year.

District Regional Membership Chair (and one of our own), **Arleen Boyuls**, gave a presentation about Membership and Extension. She noted that the RI Board of Directors adopted a new membership slogan, "Each



Rotarian: Reach One, Keep One". This slogan emphasizes the need to focus on both recruitment and retention in membership effort. This year's Presidential Citation

program provides a menu of challenging activities and to qualify for a citation, clubs should complete the membership goal, which for many clubs is probably the most difficult. The goal is to have a net increase of at least one member by March 31, 2010. (Ed.: This should be an easy thing for our Club to do!) To do this, we need to increase the diversity of our membership by recruiting at least two new members who belong to a demographic group (profession, age, religion, ethnicity, etc.) and to recruit at least two new members who have experience in community, vocational, or international service work.

Arleen conducted a survey of the Club by asking members the following questions:

- What aspect of the Club should be attractive to new members?
- What aspects of the Club could pose barriers to attracting new members?
- What are some suggestions to develop a plan to have the Club reflect the diversity of the Community?
- What information about requirements for membership should be explained to potential members?
- How should we mentor new members?
- What type of recognition should be awarded Club members who sponsor new members?

Please review these questions and give **Arleen** additional input.

Ed: We do need to increase our membership if we are to have a vibrant Club that in fact adheres to Service Above Self. There are many contributions we can make to the Green Valley community, but we must have membership in quantity and in quality that is willing to participate in Club activities.

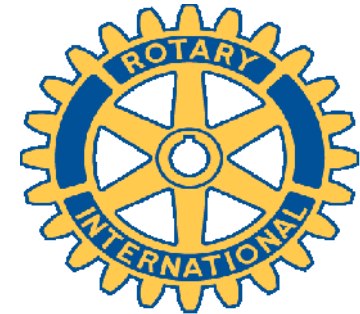

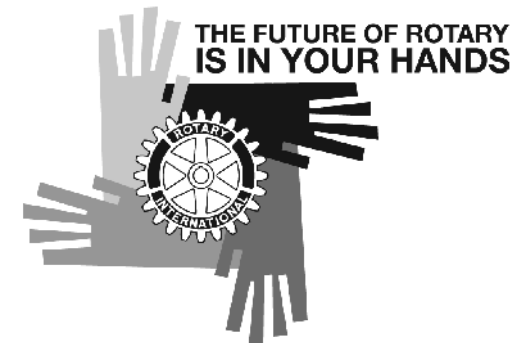
The Desert Wheel
