U.S. Border Patrol Agent Al White, in charge of the Nogales Station, noted that the Tucson sector was the busiest in the U.S. He said that the goal of the Border Patrol is "Operational Control of Our Nation's Borders". The Tucson sector is in control of 262 miles of border or 91,000 square miles. They employ 3,300 agents to work this area. White said that in 2008, there were 299,000 apprehensions in this sector and that 25% of narcotics seized are at the checkpoint on I-19. So far in 2009, 52,000 illegals have been apprehended and 1.1M lbs of marijuana have been seized. Arizona only has one permanent checkpoint and that is in Yuma. Illegals apprehended are given a free flight back to Mexico City and this averages about 266 people a day during this season. The Nogales station has 32 miles of border to patrol and of this, 12 miles have fencing. The B.P. hopes to have a temporary station up and running by May 2010 and a GAO study will determine if and when a permanent station will be erected on I-19. The B.P. is also closely watching the flow of weapons and cash leaving the U.S. destined for Mexico.

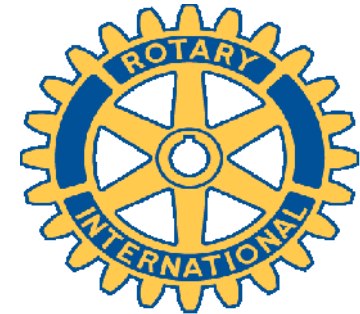

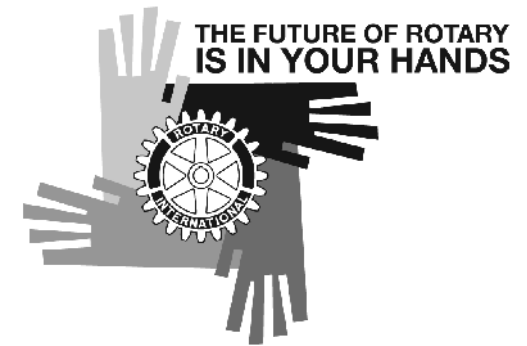
The Desert Wheel
