Andy Heideman noted that there will be a Polio + fund raising program that will entice us to contribute \$X for each game our team (college or pro) wins. Details forthcoming.

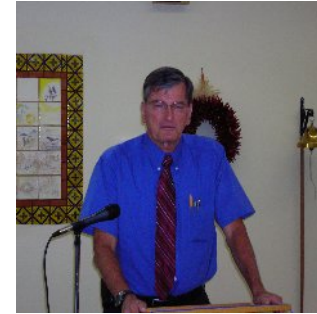

**Program:**

Hank Atha, Deputy County Administrator for Community Services and Economic Development, addressed us on Pima County issues in these areas. Atha is responsible for

services that include the Library District, Stadium District, Recreation Centers and federally funded employment and training programs. Pima County does not do economic development, but contracts with TREO (Tucson Regional Economic Opportunities, Inc.) and the Chamber of Commerce for these services. Alta noted that housing was slow in Pima County and that only 62 permits were taken out in August '09 for new homes, compared to 602 permits in August of '05. He said that many of the recent permits were taken out for development in the Canoa Ranch area. He said that TREO priorities are in Aerospace, Energy/Solar, Bio Sciences, and Transportation & Logistics. In Aerospace, Raytheon has half of the manufacturing jobs in the county and that Davis-Monthan AFB and the UofA are the big drivers in employment in Pima County. In the field of Bio Science, agriculture plays a big part in the County followed by the medical field. Many sites in Pima County are being studied for solar energy projects that will generate from 1 mw to 25 mw of power. One mw of power will support the energy for 180 homes. Alta noted that Target has recently opened a distribution center that employs 300 people. The county works on "Quality of Life" projects that include recreation, parks, libraries, education, arts, museums, etc. Alta noted that \$107M is being spent on projects in the Green Valley area that include the East Frontage Road alignment, Performing Arts Center, Library enhancement and a few other projects.

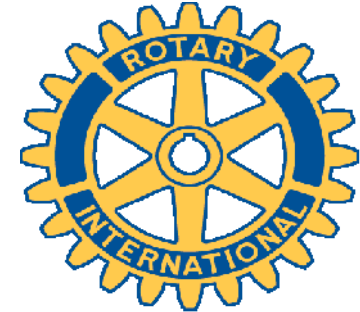

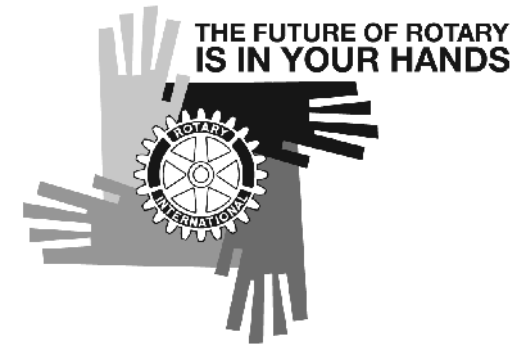
