Santa Cruz County Sheriff Tony Estrada has been in the law enforcement business for 40 years and has been the Sheriff of Santa Cruz County since 1993. He is in his 5th term in office. His office has 1240 square miles to cover and 50 miles of border. The Sheriff's Department is the smallest along the border and works with approximately 40,000 residents in Santa Cruz County and 400,000 residents in Nogales, Sonora. The Sheriff noted that in 1995 things started falling apart along the border with cross-border crime and they had major arrests of people from Sonora, Mexico. He stated that in 1995 there were 70 Border Patrol people in Santa Cruz County and in 2009 there are 600 patrolling the area. 20-30% of the residents of the jail in the county are Mexican Nationals. A ½ ¢ sales tax in the county is going to allow for the expansion of the county jail. There are tens of thousands of visitors and commercial vendors from both the U.S. and Mexico who pass through the area on a daily basis. In addition to handling the various issues caused by a transient population, however peaceful, the department must also address a crime rate disproportionate to the county's home population. Due to its location on the border, SCC has one of the highest percentage of law enforcement officials in the nation for its size.
