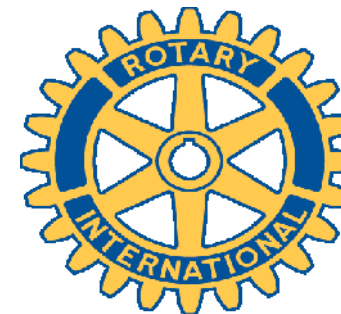

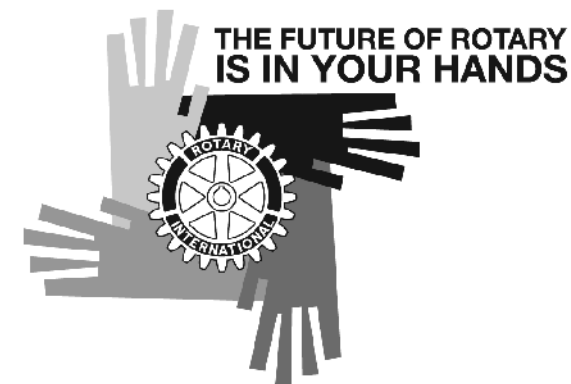
The Desert Wheel
