Barb & Bob Mengebier of Valley Presbyterian Church spoke on the Stephen Ministry program. Stephen Ministry is a program for training and organizing lay people to provide one-to-one Christian care to hurting people in and around their congregation and the community.



The Stephen Ministry provides congregations with the structure, training, and resources to set up and administer a complete system for lay caring ministry in the congregation. In Stephen Ministry congregations, lay caregivers provide one-to-one care to the bereaved, hospitalized, terminally ill, separated, divorced, unemployed, relocated, and others facing a crisis or life challenge. Stephen Ministry helps pastors and congregations provide quality caring ministry for as long as people need it.

The Stephan Ministry started worldwide in 1975 and was started at Valley Presbyterian in 1996 by 5 church members. The membership is now over 100.

Barb and Bob noted that in working with clients, maintaining confidentiality is of the utmost importance. They also noted that in Green Valley loneliness was very prevalent and one of the factors they ran into quite often.

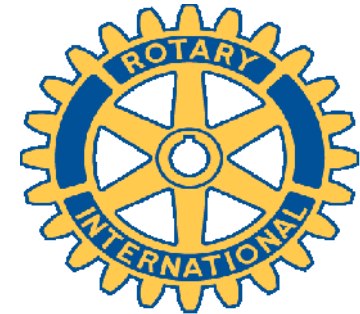
