### Program (Chair: Larry DeLong)

**Dr. Daniel Wegener**, President of the Interfaith Council of the Santa Cruz Valley, spoke to the Club on Nov. 24. Dr. Wegener has worked with the United Nations to further the civil rights of people in emerging nations all over the world.



He discussed the important role of the International Rotary organization as a powerful force to influence governments to promote civil rights for their citizens.

Dr. Wegener spoke a good deal about tolerance, and he asked Club members for a definition. New sojourner **Ernie Gilliatt** (Guelph, Ontario, CAN) revealed an engineering background by describing tolerance as a looseness between parts. Others emphasized understanding and acceptance. Dr. Wegener took it a step further with the idea of empathy. He also frequently referred to "civil organization," of which the interfaith council is an example, groups of people getting together with other groups to get things done for the benefit of all. Santa Cruz Valley Interfaith Council includes groups from Sahuarita down to Amado.
