Program – Family Services Lifeline



Sandy Wahl, a 15-year Rotarian and Past President of the Tucson Sunrise Club, spoke about Our Family Services Lifeline, which is the the push-button

you can wear around your neck to summon help when you've fallen down and can't get up. It operates up to 700 ft from its base unit, which connects to the home telephone landline. The Lifeline helps subscribers maintain independent living, and it can reduce the "lie time" (lying there helplessly enduring the pain) to just a few minutes. Family Services also provides a medicine dispensing machine, which reduces the risk of unplanned hospitalization from medication error, the other common danger to older adults.
