Program – Dennis Fischer – Rosemont Copper

UofA educated geological engineer and Tucson native, Fischer has 27 years experience in mining. In a detailed Powerpoint presentation he dispelled the misinformation associated with the proposed Rosemont copper mine. In the 60+ years since the last such mine was started in the US, huge advances have been made in dealing with ecological impact. "Reclamation is #1 with us." The mine will recharge 105% of the water it uses back into the water table. It will produce lost cost, low risk, high quality copper, employ 400 – 450 people and support 3 times that many.
