Robert Lehnhardt – Expanded Economic Report

Past Club President (2001), **Robert** has a daughter (17) at home and a son at ASU. He's been a Rotarian since 1996.

Robert addressed some common questions about inflation. He said it's a myth that the Fed has to choose between growth and inflation. They do need to transition to a tight economy, but they have at least 3 years to do it. The 2009 inflation rate (whole year) was -0.4%. The Federal Reserve created \$1.4 trillion in bank reserves that would have been inflationary if unemployment were low, but when a country is coming out of a recession it is not utilizing all of its production capacity, so inflation remains low. As productivity and employment increase, the Fed can slow the bank credit cycle by increasing interest rates.

We've learned from Japan not to make policy too restrictive too soon, and from Greece that capital markets are still fragile. The demise of the dollar is not near; during the crisis its value went up.

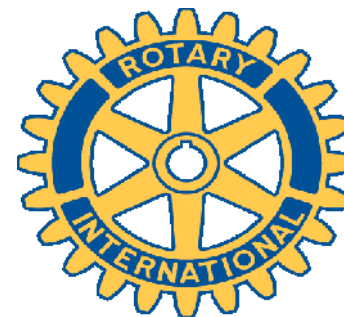

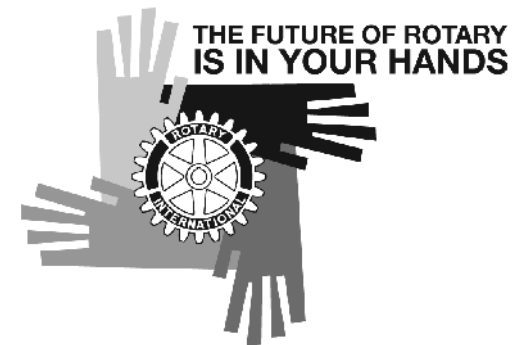
