The Rotary Club of Green Valley is competing with the Valle Verde and Tubac Rotary clubs to help the Green Valley Community Food Bank.

Our last minute pledges put us past Valle Verde's contributions last year. We took in \$2918 in cash which converted to 15,688 pounds. Last year Valle Verde had 15,139 pounds. Unfortunately for us (but very nice for the Food Bank), this year Valle Verde collected \$5,563, which converted to 28,483 pounds. The Food Bank will be able to use the Rotary contributions toward a Feinstein Matching Grant.

Program – Jim DiGiacomo, Chamber of Commerce

DiGiacomo, a 29 year resident, has been with the Chamber since 1984 and Director for 8 years. His update touched on several topics. The bed tax issue has reached a compromise after 5 years of effort, gaining for our area a percentage of Tucson's tax.



In the last year 49 businesses closed, but 16 new ones opened last month, including salons, a restaurant, a cleaning service, and others. Cadden Management regrouped, Dave Polsky added Hertz to his business, and UPH has opened a new clinic. The Carondelet hospital is on hold, but Northwest Hospital, which "knows how to do urgent care," is looking at Green Valley. The Chamber has written a letter as a followup to GVCCC urging that the Sahuarita landfill remain open. And Fairfield is planning new developments in our area.

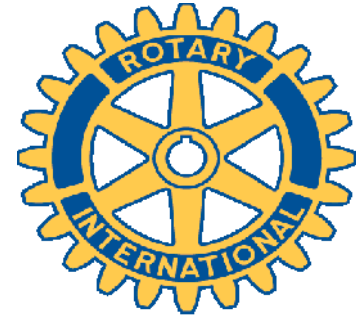

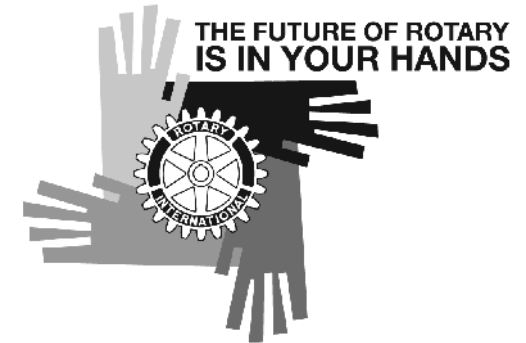
