**Sahuarita Educational Enrichment Foundation**

**Mac Chernoski**, who was an award-winning teacher over a 33-year career, spoke to the Club about SEEF, which was founded in 2003. She is currently its president. SEEF is a 501(c)3 nonprofit whose mission is to enrich the educational opportunities in the Sahuarita Unified School District and in the communities it serves.



SEEF gives mini grants of \$500 to teachers, who often spend hundreds or even thousands of their own dollars in their classrooms. The grants make possible many unique and engaging experiences for students, such as Gail Terhune's science project at SMS, where students built bridges, rocket launchers, and such using deductive skills learned in their classroom.

SEEF also gives college scholarships; they've awarded \$25,000 to 33 students, and they include community service along with financial need and academic merit in their selection process.

SEEF supports Sopori Preschool, which enhances children's socialization skills and leads to much better performance in elementary school. They also support LINK, a licensed childcare program, and of course, the Amado-Sahuarita Adult Learning Program which our own **Shawna Hansen** directs.

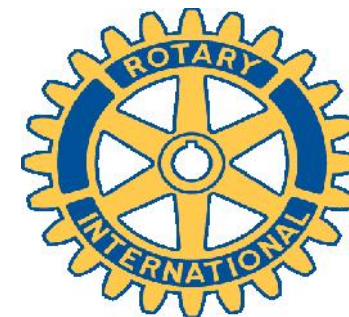
