**Can Money Buy Happiness?**



**Kirk Reed**, a 3<sup>rd</sup> generation Rotarian whose grandfather was a charter member, and who was a Methodist pastor for 37 years, is Chair of the District Endowment Committee and author of the book *Happy Money*. He used behavioral economics to examine the relationship between money and happiness.

He said money can buy happiness if we buy experiences, not stuff. Experiences connect us to other people, provide us with good stories, and give us meaningful memories that improve satisfaction over time.

We should make what we buy a treat, special, novel, exciting.

We should buy time, avoiding the things that drag us down, increasing happiness with things like social interaction, exercise, and such.

We should pay now and consume later, like on a cruise ship. Use debit, not credit.

And we should invest in others. A Rotary Endowment is an excellent way to do that.

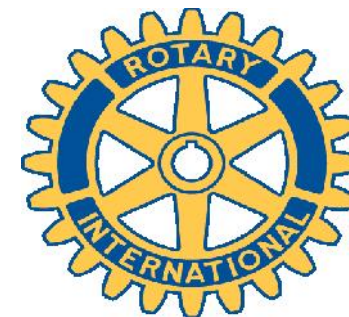
