AZ Air National Guard



Col. Kenneth Rosson spoke to the Club about the AZ Air National Guard and their mission, which includes F-16 fighter training for the USAF and partner nations, the 214th Reconnaissance Group,

Aerospace Control Alert (defending US airspace), and the ANG/AFRC Test Center, which does tactics development and evaluation. He said perhaps the greatest thing about Tucson for the purposes of their missions is the great flying area, the great weather. He also pointed out they are the 40th largest employer in AZ with an economic impact of \$250,000,000 per year. He has been flying F-16's since the Viet Nam era.

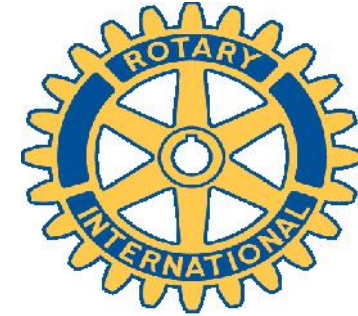
