Club Foundation / Food Fight

Foundation President **Mary Jane Goodrick** told us we gave \$1500 in scholarships this year, but to sustain our scholarship fund more of us need to be contributing to our Club Foundation, which lost \$8000 last month because interest income was greater than donations and that affected tax status.



Under her other hat as Community Food Bank Director, she announced the beginning of our annual Food Fight with Valle Verde. We have until the end of the month to whup 'em.

Community Performing and Arts Center



CPAC Executive Director **Chris Ashcraft** shared with us the history of CPAC from its beginnings in 1999, its county bond funding in 2005 and 2009,

and its current state as a facility shared with Pima Community College, who sublease their half to OLLI. CPAC puts on 100 shows a year ranging from 1 person shows to large ensembles. They also host summer camps for the arts and even weddings. They have a staff of 5 but only 2 of them full time. They now have reserved seating, which allows people to arrive just 15 minutes before the show rather than an hour to claim a good seat. They are in a campaign to replace the seats in their 200-seat theater and are halfway to their goal, hoping to do the installation in August. They are a 501(c)3 organization, and ticket sales provide only 1/3 of their \$400,000 annual budget.

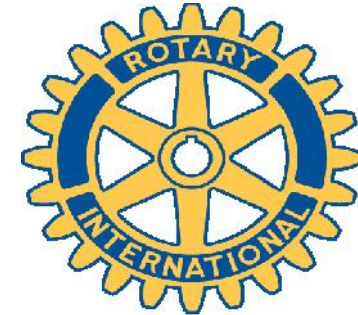
