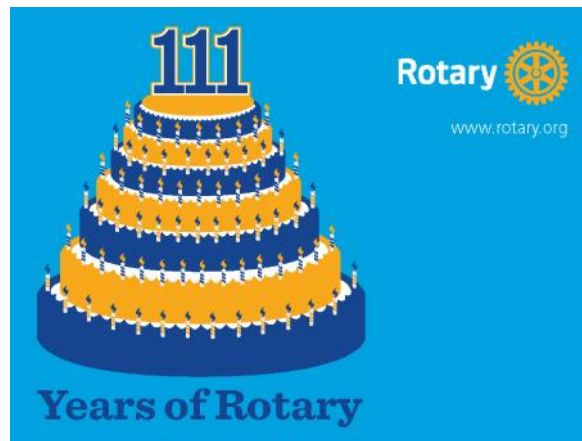
Duck Dash

Maximizing Independence with Therapy



Cindy Levy is an occupational therapist with over 17 years of experience and is Supervisor of Out-patient Therapy at La Posada. She dispelled several myths about therapy and

discussed the benefits. We don't need a serious problem to seek therapy; it can be used as a "tune up" and to help with day to day challenges. Physical therapy isn't necessarily painful but can be used to ease pain and improve quality of life. Occupational therapy isn't about jobs but rather about the daily tasks like putting on shoes and socks that can become difficult late in life. Most speech therapy patients are adults who need help with language, memory, or swallowing disorders. While PT focuses on strength, endurance, and gross motor skills, OT focuses on coordination, range of motion, and fine motor skills.

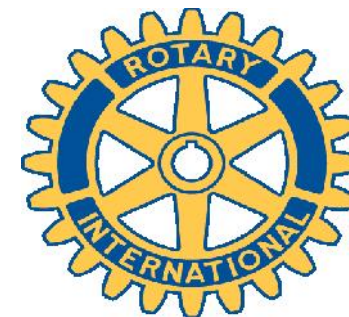
