Club Foundation Update



Al Saterbak, Club Foundation Treasurer presented a breakdown of Foundation finances, saying that the income of \$3400 doesn't cut it in this economy. **Joyce Finkelstein**, Found-

ation VP, reminded us we used to support several scholarship students, \$1000 per year for all 4 years, but now we can only give 1 year's support. She asked us to "give 'til it helps." Foundation President **Mary Jane Goodrick** asked everyone to contribute at least something each quarter and passed out sign-up sheets (which can be returned to Secretary **Michael Pease**) to be made part of quarterly billing.

Overcoming Adversity

Nile Ramsbottom was raised on a farm and worked for Purina for 33 years after college, 16 years as an executive officer in St. Louis. When he was 55 Koch bought Purina and fired all its executives. He found a job in Iowa, where he took a local company national and then global. He turned their attempt at a soy WD-40 look-alike into one of the earliest biodiesel producers. He described the challenges of designing an efficient production system, establishing a distribution system, and all that goes into building the largest biodiesel company in North America, worth \$1.5 billion with 100,000 employees.

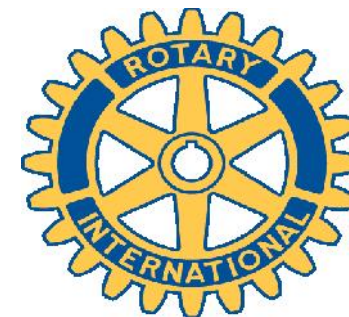
