Thinking Outside the Box



Club Secretary and former math and philosophy teacher **Michael Pease** used a triangle, a square, and a circle as metaphors for very different views about God, but completely forgot to pull out his

visual aid that showed all 3 2-dimensional figures as profiles of one solid object. His careful analysis of a 3-way duel between shooters with different skill levels used probability trees and just basic junior high fraction



arithmetic, but even that went over the heads of many. His point was that the math was the box that creative thinking had to go beyond, that the best chance for the weakest dueler came from not being the one to shoot first. He used the Ajo bottleneck on the I-19 to illustrate that normal human selfishness causes problems that the idealistic logic of the highway engineer thought to avoid, and that the same kind of selfishness is all it took to doom the Marxist ideal to failure, something predicted years earlier by ecologist Garrett Hardin. He ended with a tongue-in-cheek homework assignment, to show that free market capitalism has the same flaw, but he noted that Rotary’s ideal of actions being fair and beneficial to all is the needed outside the ego-box thinking that might save us.

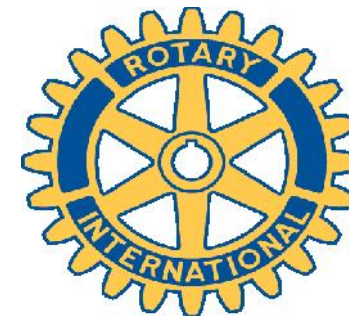
