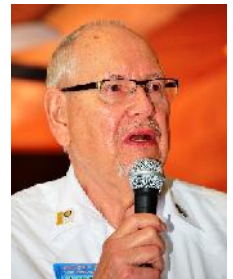

**Paul Bond Boots**

May program chair **Marvin Hass**, our own Prairie Poet, introduced the subject of the talk with a poem, in which Paul Bond Boots were featured. Sales Manager **Art Jeong** went on to share some of the history of the 70-year-old company. He said **Paul Bond** used to



break horses for the US Cavalry and was part of the original rodeo circuit, doing trick riding and Roman riding (2 horses at once). He started making boots for

the movie cowboys when so many Westerns were filmed at Old Tucson. The handmade, custom fitted boots can take 6 months to make (it isn't easy finding same-aged matching alligators), and the company is happy if they make 2000 a year. They employ 16 craftspeople, 6 of whom have been with the company 20 years. Nestor's (our server at the Grill) father worked there 26 years. Boots start at about \$900, then add \$2500 for American Alligator. But they last for decades. They are on West Paul Bond Drive in Nogales.

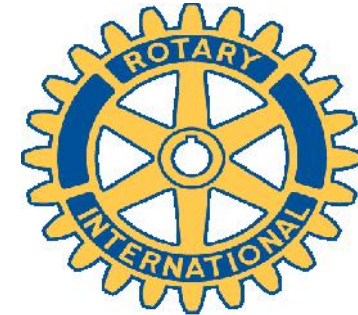
