MAP Dashboard Demographics

MAP, which means Making Action Possible, partners with Southern Arizona Leadership Council, the Community Foundation of Southern Arizona, and the U of A



Economic and Business Research Center. Their mission is to measurably improve Southern Arizona through data driven collective civic action and education.

Jennifer Pullen, a research economist with the Research Center and the MAP Program Coordinator, gave the Club a thorough introduction to their amazing website and the information it provides. It has more than 14,000 trend analyses, special reports, and white papers that span local, regional, and national statistics, and they are continually updated. 6 areas are looked at using 36 indicators: education, economy, health and social well-being, infrastructure, quality of life, and workforce and demographics. The site puts up featured articles roughly every 2 weeks. The Arizona focus includes 15 counties and 25 Southern Arizona cities.

What is more impressive, though, are the stunning visual presentations of the information, almost all of which are interactive. One can pick a category, such as educational attainment, then get a summary, maps, or tailor a graph to compare selected cities. The site has helped over 17,000 people to develop better proposals, establish benchmarks to measure success, track progress, identify trends and opportunities, and inspire action with the most current facts. One can sign up for notifications of updates. The website is
