Scholarships

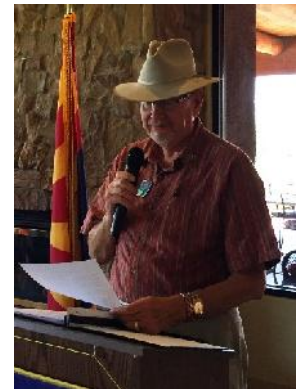

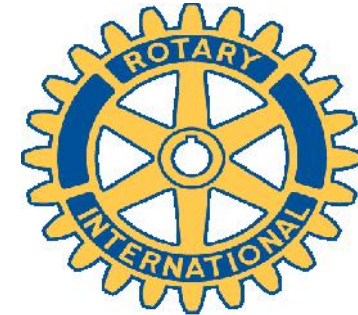
