Fourth of July Flags

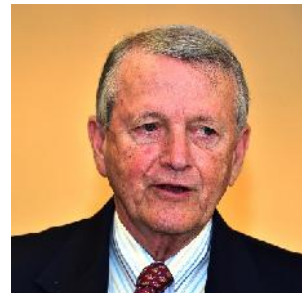


President-elect **Andy Heideman** is still passing around a sign-up sheet for 4th of July Flags, and he's also handing out forms for each member to provide a brief biography. These

Hang Up – Shred -- Delete

Lou Sampson is the no-nonsense leader of the GV Sheriff's Auxiliary Volunteers Scam Squad. She gave us a quick review of SAV – 35-year history, 80,000 hours of service from 135 volunteers this last year, house check



service that has found suitcases left on the sidewalk, memory impaired unit that helps find seniors who have wandered off, even directing traffic – but her focus was the scam squad which she started in 2012. A friend begged her to stop her husband from giving away all their savings in the belief he'd be getting \$450,000 in return. She had to show up in a squad car and in uniform to talk sense into him. She said Green Valley is targeted because of the senior population, that new widows and widowers are vulnerable to emotion, which is the enemy of critical thinking. In another story, a senior's "grandson" called from Mexico desperate for money. Her advice, instead of calling the back and arranging a payment, call the grandson. Over 20% of people over 65 have fallen prey to such schemes.

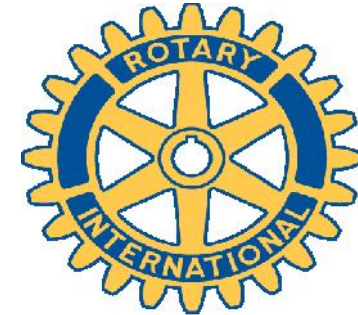
