**Scholarship Thanks**



**Madison St. John**, one of our scholarship winners from SHS, thanked us in person. She is planning to attend the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, where she will study sociology with an eye on criminology and profiling as a career. Our members gave her plenty of advice about things to see and do in Vegas.

**Tucson Clean and Beautiful**

**B J. Cordova**, Past-president of the Tucson Sunset Rotary Club and now a member of eClub of the Sonoran Desert, joined the staff of Tucson Clean and Beautiful 14 years ago. He explained that the organization works to improve our



area's environment and quality of life through education stewardship, and action. Their Adopt-a-Park program, part of land stewardship, loans supplies for clean-ups. They have a waste reduction and recycling education hotline (791-5000) as well as an online directory. They do e-waste and document collection events, and partner with household hazardous waste collection. They help subsidize trees for home and community shade. Since 1989 they've provided 160,000 desert adapted trees that provide 2 square miles of canopy and 1 billion fewer gallons of storm runoff. A home with well-shaded walls can save \$20/month on energy bills and would likely sell for \$20,000 more than otherwise. Their goal, to achieve a 24% tree canopy for the city (now just 6%), requires 80,000 more trees each year for the next 20 years. Want to help?

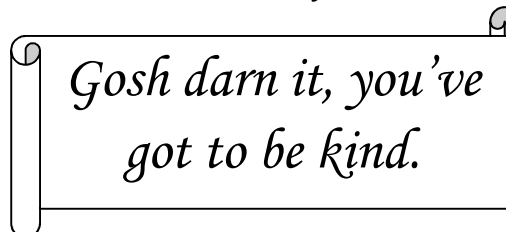
