RI Convention, Seoul



Despite the technical difficulties – our Club's media projector was built before HDMI existed – Valle Verde President **Alex Droban** gave us an outstanding presentation about Seoul, South Korea. The trip was a big adventure for him, and the ¾ mountainous

country made a great impact on him. Half of South Korea's 50 million people live in (or very near) Seoul, which he said is as modern as San Francisco. It is home to Kia, LG, Hyundai, and Samsung. The country's economy has been growing by 10%/yr. Their high-speed rail system takes 100,000 people a day from Pusan to Seoul in just 2 hours instead of the 8 it would take us to do. He described his visit to a temple built in 1395, and to the King's palaces that had over 500 buildings on the grounds. He recounted losing his cell phone in a cab and his surprise when it was returned to his hotel.

At the convention itself where 43,000 registered, he heard a lot of accolades for Arizona's efforts to fight polio. He mentioned a filtered water project in Nogales involving 120 schools that we might get involved with. And of course, kimchi. ~~~
