Rotary Vocational Fund

Visiting Rotarian **Lee Derringer** gave us a quick overview of the Rotary Vocational Fund of Arizona. Applicants must meet financial need requirements, seek training in a qualifying vocational area, be a resident of Arizona, attend a school/training institution in Arizona, and be sponsored by an Arizona Rotary Club. Town of Sahuarita

Sahuarita Mayor **Duane Blumberg**, a PhD in mathematics, came to Sahuarita in 2005, joined the Town Council in 2009, and became Mayor in 2011. He reviewed with us the town’s strengths and weaknesses and its hopes for the future.



The town was incorporated in 1994, covers at present 30 sq miles, and has a population of 28,000. Median household income is just under \$70,000. 81% of homes are occupied by their owners, and average home value is \$161,000. The 168 businesses employ 3181 people, and the population has been growing at about 2% a year since 2010. The strengths include a highly educated population and proximity to both Tucson and Mexico on the I-19 corridor. It is rated the safest city in Arizona.

On the other hand it has a limited economic base, lacking jobs commensurate with the education and skills of its people and lacking things for people of all ages to do. The town would like to expand to the east, the only way it can go, but that’s State Trust land, and the town is still haggling with the state.
