**Foundation Annual Meeting**



Club Foundation President **Mary Jane Goodrick** said the purpose of our Foundation is to transform our gifts into projects that change lives close to home, to look for solutions that leave a lasting impact.

We give 3 \$1000 scholarships each year to local high school or home schooled students, financially support local non-profits, our exchange student, and send at least one student to RYLA.

She reviewed the Roger Baxter Society, 3 ways to make a lasting (\$2500) gift to the Foundation. And she reviewed the foundation’s budget for the year.

Currently we have \$167,000 in the education endowment at USB and \$60,000 in the general fund. We anticipate earning 5% on the investments, \$2500 from gifts from members, and \$800 from Club fundraisers, for a total of \$14,300. Expenses are anticipated to be \$3000 in scholarships, \$3000 in local grants, \$1750 for exchange student costs, \$400 for RYLA, and \$4000 for investment, legal, and accounting costs. That total is \$12,150, with an expected net of \$2150.

**Mary Jane** added that because of his stroke, **Al Saterbak** will not be returning as Foundation Treasurer. Any volunteers?
