100 Years of Excellence

Mary McNichols, besides being the first Principal at Continental Elementary School, is also one of its former students. She is a graduate of Sahuarita High School and the University of Arizona, where she majored in math and history. She became principal after 13 years teaching middle school math, science, and technology and as a math specialist.



McNichols reviewed the 100-year history of Continental School by reminding us what the world was like 100 years ago: a loaf of bread was 7¢, coffee was 15¢ a pound, and a house cost \$5000. Light switches were new things, as was Einstein's General Theory of Relativity. The Town of Continental was built to accommodate the workers at Intercontinental's rubber farm, which later turned to cotton, and then under FICO to pecans. The school moved to its present location in 1973. It underwent renovations with a bond issue in 2012 (the current ballot item simply continues it). Enrollment in the early 1920's was about 40 students. It rose and fell over the years with changes in the economy, 200 students in the early 80's, then 60 less when the copper mines scaled back, 275 in 1999, and now over 600. The school's motto, "Building for the Future," poses a challenge when so many things can change.
