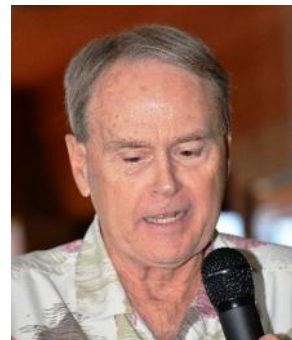
Sports Challenge

Games You Can't Lose (if You're the Casino)

Club Secretary **Michael Pease**, who taught math (shudder) and philosophy for 33 years, talked to the Club about how con artists and casinos take advantage of people's inability to count correctly the outcomes of games. A simple example involved 2 cards, one red on both sides, the other red on one side, black on the other. If one is on the table showing red side up, the con offers even odds the other side is red, People who aren't careful counting take the bet, but the odds are actually 2 to 1, meaning the con will win 2/3 of the time instead of half.



A famous misunderstanding much like this is the Monty Hall problem, where there are 1 car and 2 goats behind 3 curtains. After the player picks a curtain, Monty shows a goat behind one of the others and gives the player a chance to switch curtains. Even professional mathematicians mistakenly believe the odds at that point are even, but in fact the player doubles his chance of winning by switching.

Finally, **Michael** worked through the math behind the game of Keno and showed how the casino picks the payoffs to guarantee that it keeps 25% of the money bet, no matter what the player does. State lotteries are basically the same game.
