District Governor

This year's District Governor, **Sheryl Christenson**, is a charter member of the Yuma Sunrise Club. She reminded us that Rotary's polio eradication efforts began in Manilla in 1980, and that this last year our world had only 23 cases. We are on the verge of wiping out a 2nd major global illness (the 1st was smallpox in the 20th Century). She considers her slogan to be "boots on the ground" because of the importance of Rotarians participating in local community projects. She is concerned about Rotary's retention problem, and we assured her our own Club is very much aware of it. She told us the 2 Rotary districts in Northern Arizona will be merging at the end of this year, becoming District 5495, and that in 2018 there will be only 1 district PETS, located at LAX. She reminded us (as we approach the end of the tax year) that contributions to the Arizona Rotary Vocational Fund qualify for tax credits. The DG said there's an online leadership academy for Club Past-presidents. The Centennial of the Foundation will be celebrated at the RI Convention in Atlanta June 10-14, and our own District Conference will be in Yuma next year April 28-30. The DG added that the District needs both a Youth Services Chairperson and a Publicity Chairperson.
