Histotechnology

Andrea Grantham retired from U of A after 15 years in research histology. She had also been clinical histology supervisor at hospitals in El Paso, in microbiology at Case Western University Hospital in Cleveland, and on a NSH scholarship helped to set up a histology lab in a women's health clinic in Cusco, Peru.



She told us histotechnology centers on detection of tissue abnormalities and the treatment for the diseases that cause them. She also pointed out that histotechnologists had significant roles in several popular medical crime shows, from Quincy to Bones and NCIS. And she described the process that a biopsy goes through. Fixation uses formaldehyde to preserve the specimen before it goes to the pathology lab, where it is first examined without a microscope, then representative sections are put into cassettes for processing, then embedded in a paraffin block, sliced into thin sections with a microtome, made into slides, and stained to reveal relevant features and structures. At the end of the process, diagnosis. The technology is a blend of art and science. They are saving lives "one slide at a time."
