**Distracted Driving**

**Vernon Harms**, Chaplain to the Highway Patrol and a former Club member, shared with us a video about distracted driving produced by DPS. Turns out distractions can be much more subtle than just gross



texting. There are 3 kinds of distractions. Manual distractions involve hands off the wheel doing things like eating, grooming, using a cell phone, adjusting the radio, and so on. Visual distractions take eyes off the road to look at passengers, scenery, maps, gps devices, attractive pedestrians, etc. Cognitive distractions take the driver's mind off the task of driving and can be as simple as a bit of day dreaming. Obviously, some distractions are a combination of these things.

Distracted driving is the #1 priority of the US Department of Transportation, but they cannot mandate rules because that area is under state jurisdiction. They tell us at any given time 660,000 drivers are using cell phones, and it turns out hands-free devices are just as distracting. **Harms** said several times that multi-tasking is a myth. Taking eyes/mind off the road for 4 seconds at 55 mph (never mind 75) is equivalent to driving the length of a football field blind. His advice is to keep the eyes moving and don't concentrate on just 1 thing.
