Sahuarita Police Chief

John Noland was a peace officer in California for 30 years, 26 of them in Santa Rosa (not quite an hour north of San Francisco), before he became Chief of the Sahuarita PD just 2 years ago. He came to the meeting after several 20-hour days dealing with a recent officer-involved shooting. He turned the investigation over to the sheriff’s department, partly for the objectivity and partly as part of a general sharing of resources among the various local agencies.



The Chief established an employee recognition program (they’d not had one), and said they are planning a TV on the lobby wall for FAQ’s and recognition. He told us their drone program had saved a dementia victim from being lost in the desert, and he said they’re using RICO money for their body cam system which should be in place in 2017, but he warned they are not a panacea. Nor are dashboard cameras.

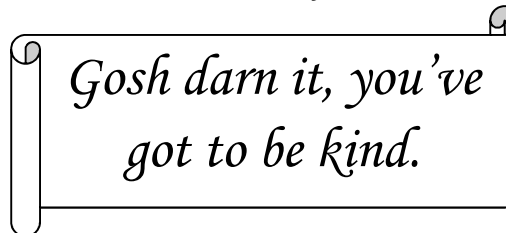
