Davis-Monthan History

Larry Herndon, Chief of History for the 355th Fighter Wing, retired from the Air Force in 2005 and has been collecting and archiving supporting documents and interviewing key personnel to ensure significant aspects of the wing's mission are preserved since 2006.



He told us that in 1919 Tucson had the first municipal airport in the US. It was relocated to its present site in 1925 and named after 2 Tucsonans who died in plane crashes in WWI. In 1927 Charles Lindbergh landed at the field on a promotional tour. DM became a military aviation training facility in 1940. It was home to the 39th Bombardment Group '42-'44. In the last half of November 1945, they out-processed 9435 personnel.

B-29's returned to DM when the Strategic Air Command was activated in 1946, and they were home to the 1st AF Refueling Squadron from 1948-1960, the 100th Strategic Reconnaissance Wing (U-2 spy planes) 1963-1974, and the 390th Strategic Missile Wing (Titan II's) 1962-1984. Over the years DM has played a key role in fighter training, recon, and even rescue. Here's wishing them clear skies.
