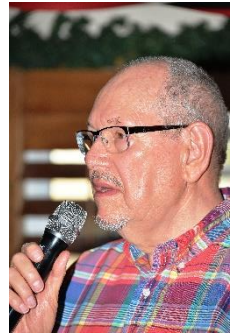

Discovery Education Science Techbooks



Kevin Harcourt, who in 2007 was an Arizona Top-Ten Teacher of the year and who taught middle school language arts, math, and drama for 20 years, has been SUSD's professional development coordinator since 2008. He reminded us what the chalkboard

classrooms of our youth was like, and stressed that in spite of changes in technology, the teacher is still the most important part of the classroom and that teaching is the profession that creates all others.

He said the techbooks are simple to use, interactive, and inquiry based. They put model lessons, assessments, and hands-on activities all in one place by combining text and media for students of different abilities and learning styles. The 5 E's of the instructional model are engage, explore, explain, elaborate, and evaluate. The STEM (science, technology, engineering, math) connections in the lessons give the students opportunities to solve real-world problems and even make career connections. The 5 year program is based on a \$53,000 grant
