SAMTEC

Victor Gonzalez, a certified economic developer with over 15 years’ experience in strategic planning, community partnership building, and economic development, is a graduate of U of A. He spoke to the Club about the Sahuarita Advanced Manufacturing and Technology Center.



Part of the motivation for it is the reduction in force at the mines (down 560 from 1300) because of the lower price of copper globally. That’s 4.6% of Sahuarita’s civilian labor force. It will be a 32,000 ft² multi-tenant center that provides flexible space for small business innovation and technologies in Sahuarita. It hopes to have 50-75 full time employees with average salaries of \$75,000 and house 4 resident companies. Funding will (hopefully) come from a grant from the Economic Development Administration and also a commitment from the Town of Sahuarita. Part of the goal is to diversify the town’s economy and reduce its dependence on the mine.

Sahuarita was notified in December that their \$3 million proposal was still being considered, subject to their submitting some additional information, which was done in January.
