Adamson-Catino Trail

Steven Anderson, Planning Division Manager for Pima County Natural Resources, Parks and Recreation Department, shared with the Club the



current status of the Pima County hiking and biking trails, especially the Adamson-Catino trail which runs 1.9 miles along the Santa Cruz River from Abrego through the FICO pecan orchards to the Canoa Preserve. They have a \$39,000 grant from Freeport McMoRan, and are coordinating with FICO and Union Pacific Railroad, which the trail goes under at one point. Work on the trail should be done by this fall. It is for hikers, bikers, and equestrians, but not for motorized vehicles.

Anderson also talked about other local Pima Co. trails, including "The Loop", a 131 mile trail around Tucson, with links to Marana, Oro Valley, and South Tucson. They are looking for grants for a trail and hiking bridge over the I-10 near Tangerine Road.
