**STEM and the Santa Rita Experimental Range**



**Martha Gebhardt**, a PhD student at U of A in the School of Natural Resources and the Environment, told us about how a grant from Freeport McMoRan is making inquiry-based field science possible for SUSD schools at the Santa Rita Experimental

Range. The funding has provided teacher training and a special program for "teen ambassadors." The kids receive training in desert ecology, local geology, natural history, leadership, and the history of the SRER. They have 2 single-day outings and 1 overnight, during which they collect data, form hypotheses, and actually implement experiments and analyze the results. The hands-on approach is fun, exciting, and increases interest in science, a subject in which students seem to lose interest after 8<sup>th</sup> grade. From 50 teen ambassadors over 2 years, 12 STEM mentors will be chosen to create lessons which will expose 600 K-8 students to the excitement of inquiry-based STEM education.
