Pima County Board Update

Steve Christy, who has been a member of the Tucson Rotary Club since the '80's and whose father and grandfather we both Rotarians, is a newly elected member of the Pima County Board of Supervisors. He had been an auto dealer, and he told us his wife's advice was, "Just fix the roads."



The bad news, he said, is that there are very little county funds for that because money has been used at the state level to fill budget holes. We've had a ½¢ tax since 2006 supporting the Regional Transportation Authority, which has expanded and improved roadways, but it was never intended for maintenance, which will require a new budget process. Out of a \$1.2 billion county budget there *ought* to be money for roads, but just to get them back to a C+ level would cost \$800 million. The RTA is a good model and is already in place, but its redirection will require an election. We could raise the tax to ¾¢, but that needs the approval of the state legislature. Alternatively we could reduce the property tax and increase the sales tax. What we need is community input and involvement.
