Science and the World

Club Secretary **Michael Pease**, as he usually does on the 3rd Tuesday, presented a few short science videos, one on genetics, one (with Muppets) on being a puppet to one's emotions, and one on the new Webb Space Telescope, which makes the Hubble look rather small. It is 3 times as wide, which gives it 9 times the light gathering power. Then a clip from *The West Wing* on the Gall-Peters projection of the world map (which removes the bias toward Europe and shows correct relative sizes of land masses) made a transition to a series of world maps (provided by **Jill Leach**) that showed where the population is, where McDonald's is, which countries were conquered by England, and so on.



Finally, still thinking globally, he presented a video from Rotary International on the critical need to get to zero polio outbreaks. Through the largest global health initiative in history, we (Rotary and WHO) went from 350,000 cases in 1988 to just 74 in 2015, but as in so many sci-fi movies, it only takes a few cases hopping around the world on airplanes to restart the epidemic. Failure to get to zero could result in 200,000 new cases per year in just 10 years.
