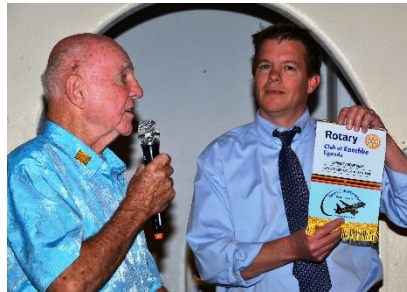

Step Up to Justice

Melissa Spiller-Shiner told us that of the 200,000 residents of Pima County that live in poverty, half of them have at least 1 civil legal need each year. Over 900 attorneys have volunteered to do something about it, building a new non-profit, Step Up to Justice, from the ground up. She quoted professor Bryan Stevenson: "Our ability to end injustice is directly tied to our capacity to create hope."



Civil legal needs include family law, minor guardianships, wills and advanced directives, bankruptcy, housing, and consumer protection. Where the staff-attorney model pairs 1 attorney with 1 client at a cost of ~\$1770 per case, their volunteer model connects multiple clients to a volunteer attorney using a variety of programs at a cost of \$110 per case. Besides cost efficiency, they make effective use of technology with a centralized system that gives clients access to forms and videos, attorneys remote access to cases, and resources for volunteers and donors. Using 2 staff attorneys, 1 paralegal, 200 volunteer attorneys, and an annual budget of \$250,000, they were able to serve 1000 clients.

SU2J also focuses on community partnerships and on providing a quality experience for their volunteers. The partnerships provide holistic service, so the clients aren't bounced from one agency to another. The quality experience for the volunteers results from the SU2J staff finding them cases to help that are a good fit.
