GV Economic Management Group



Kelly Cooper, a former master tennis pro and coach, told the Club that volunteers are the biggest beauty of Green Valley, but that part of the difficulty of "many plans, no action" has been the issues of cooperation and credit. The management group

includes 2 representatives from each of GVR, Green Valley Council, and the Chamber of Commerce, plus 4 at large and **Cooper** himself. He said that what's tough in the community is communication, the problem his group is intended to overcome. Their current resolution aims at economic development. Part of that is the grant from Freeport to develop the RetireAZ website to bring more people here. Freeport appreciates the coordination among the community organizations. He mentioned that the hospital's new CEO has experience rescuing hospitals from "deep doodoo." A good hospital, he said, is essential for economic growth.
