**CPAC Update**



**Chris Ashcraft**, who loves his job as Executive Director of the Community Performing and Arts Center so much he doesn't mind the daily drive to Green Valley from NE Tucson, gave us an annual update on the Center and its programs.

It was incorporated in 1999 and built by the county in 2 phases, financed by a bond issue and a ½ million-dollar matching grant from Freeport. The Pima College side was leased to OLLI in 2009. The CPAC Foundation is a 501(c)3 nonprofit with 5 paid staffers and an all-volunteer executive board. Their budget this year is ½ million.

**Chris** showed pictures of the 203-seat auditorium, where the seats have recently been very solidly anchored down, as well as pictures of the art exhibit that rotates monthly. The Center hosts 100 concerts, yoga and art classes, town hall meetings, a summer camp that ends with performances by the kids, a lot of tribute shows, a 100-voice community choir, and the Continental School Fundraiser. This year's tributes include John Denver, Chicago, Karen Carpenter, Donna Summer, and Barry Manilow.

**Chris** emphasized that volunteers are crucial for CPAC's activities. Ticket money pays only 1/3 of the cost of their operation, so donations and volunteers are essential. Much more information at --
