**Rotary Vocational Fund**

"The Rotary Vocational Fund of Arizona gives qualified students the opportunity to realize their dream of a vocational education that provides a living wage." **Aziz Ajel** applied for this with our Club, and was unanimously approved by the Board. He is finishing a program of aviation technology at Pima Community College. He'll receive \$3000 from the Vocational Fund (no cost to the Club).



**FITSS**

**Penny Pestle**, who has degrees from Harvard and Yale, has experience in both small business and corporate settings and in nonprofit leadership as well. She told us that FITTS (From Insufficiency to Self-Sufficiency) is the result of a collaborative study by the Food Bank, the Community Foundation, and 20 other stakeholders. The goal was to forge an understanding of the nature of poverty in greater Sahuarita and Green Valley. They found the official poverty rate is between 5% and 6%, with poorer pockets in unincorporated areas, but closer to 25% are living without adequate economic resources. 700 local grandparents are raising their grandkids. Greatest unmet needs are affordable housing, jobs and job skills, lower health care bills, and food. There is also need for family assistance, elderly care, school services, public transportation, affordable day care, and effective community advertising. They recommend working groups (employer, school resources, and human services) that focus on collaboration and communication among agencies and clients, aiming at solutions that are sustainable.
