Hurricane Relief

United Community Health Center

Dr. Rodolfo Jimenez, who completed medical school in 1990 and his residency in 1993, told us he found private practice unfulfilling, but his work at Marana Community Health Center was. He told us there was a health center movement early in the 20th century that faded by the 30's, but it re-emerged in 1964 with the Economic Opportunity Act. Community Health Centers are non-profit, community directed, located in high need areas, open to all residents, provide high quality care, and are affordable and cost effective. Today there are over 9800 centers, more than half rural, serving more than 25 million patients, including 300,000 vets and 1.2 million homeless.



Wendy Kibby, who was a nurse at St. Joseph, said our center includes a pediatric dental service that can visit schools, and it has a lot of focus on preventive care. UCHC provides transportation services, collaborates with pharmacies, accepts all insurance, and has a system of sliding fees.
