Final Exit Network

Rev. John Abraham has more than 40 years of experience as counselor, therapist, patient-care advocate, as well as being an Episcopal priest and thanatologist, and the author of How to Get the Death You Want.



He said the Right to Die will be America's next civil right

and that 2/3 of Americans support it. He said most people would prefer to die at home, but 80% die in hospitals that seem set on keeping them miserable as long as possible. Final Exit Network is a national non-profit organization that supports the right to die with dignity for mentally competent adults who are suffering with an irreversible illness or intractable pain. They provide support for a peaceful death, information, and education. They provide advocacy training and advance directives workshops. **Abraham** emphasized that people have the right to refuse treatment, and he advised us to take our advocates with us to meetings with the medical establishment.
