Just Fix the Roads

County Supervisor **Steve Christy** chose our Club meeting as the place to announce his “Just Fix the Road” plan, in part because both **Dick Roberts** and **Chet Davis** work with the RTA, and in part because Green Valley has some of the county’s worst roads. He said Pima County has 1200 miles of roads rated poor or failed and that this is the most important issue facing the county. There is little hope getting funding from the general fund or from raising the gas tax. His plan made 3 points.



First, the Board should repeal the recent property tax increase, which will only raise \$19 million toward a \$100 million - \$1 billion problem.

Second, establish a county-wide ½¢ sales tax, which would raise \$75 million annually.

Third, give all revenue from the new tax to the RTA, which has a proven record of over 1000 projects completed on time and under budget, and which passed a recent audit with praise and commendation. 99% of the money would go to road repair, only 1% to administration.

The plan would include a sunset clause of 10 years. It would let our winter visitors and tourists contribute to the roads they’re using, not just the property owners. Food and medicine would not be taxed. The plan would allow increasing road capacity as well as making repairs. **Dick** said a list of failed Green Valley roads was being submitted to RTA that very day. The key obstacle: a 5-0 vote by the Board of Supervisors is needed.
