Green Valley Fire Department

LT Pratt had a 30-year career with the Pima County Sheriff's Department, serving as District Commander (8 yr), Commander of the Homeland Security Section (4 yr), and also Commander of Criminal Investigations (3 yr). His certifications include mass disaster and terrorism, critical incident stress management, prevention and response to suicide bombing incidents, pandemic influenza planning and preparedness, WMD awareness, and hazards incident management (to name a few).



But it was **Chuck Wunder** who asked him back to Green Valley Fire Department. **Pratt** said Green Valley is the best assignment in his 30-year career, that Green Valley felt like "old home week." It is a new adventure in his personal life and gives him a chance to contribute to the community. He said he was amazed at the many programs of GVFD, mentioning lock boxes, nurse practitioners, and the Fire Corps. He expressed concern that compared to fire heroes, society seems to be "degrading" law enforcement. He told us that the Sheriff's Auxiliary Volunteers have (in the last year?) installed 3500 smoke alarms, 476 lock boxes, and changed out 11,000 batteries. **Pratt** also talked at length about SHiM (Safety and Health in Motion) and fall prevention for seniors. He said 1 out of 3 adults 65 years and older fall each year, that falls are the leading cause of death due to injuries, and 1 in 4 individuals restrict their activities because of fear of falling. In response to questions **Pratt** said he spent 58 days in a 2-man tent during what has been the worst fire season in a decade. He advised we all become fire wise and keep the wildland back. He's been married 35 years, has 3 adult kids and a granddaughter.
